The March to the Arch is a 21 mile memorial group walk that begins west of St. Louis and concludes at the base of the Gateway Arch. Bo Drochelman started this annual walk in 2002 in remembrance of the Americans who lost their lives in the 9/11 tragedy. Gateway Milers invite Volkssporters to join this memorial walk. The 21 mile walk begins at 9:11 am on Monday September 11, 2017. The 10K walk joins the walkers at the St. Louis History Museum in Forest Park. The 5K walk joins walkers at Tegler Hall on SLU campus. All registered walkers are given a t-shirt and encouraged to carry flags.

START LOCATION: The 34k (21 mile) starting point will be at Mike Duffy's Restaurant at 141 and Clayton Road, Chesterfield, MO. The 10K will start at the History Museum in Forest Park. The 5K starts at Tegler Hall on Lindell (1 block east of Grand Ave).

PARKING: Mike Duffy's or History Museum, or metered street parking and parking garage on Olive and Compton. Metrolink to Forest Park or Grand Ave.

<u>TIME</u>: Start time is 9:11 am for 34K, approximately 3:30pm for 10K, approximately 4:30 pm for 5K.

REGISTRATION: This walk is a pre-registered walk only. You must pre-register by 7/31/2017. The Gateway Milers will submit registration of our walkers to the March to the Arch website. Fee is \$3 for all walkers. Event will take place regardless of weather. No refund will be given. Event is open to the public. This event counts toward acquisition of IVV achievement awards. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12.

PROCEDURE: The 34K (21 mile) at Mike Duffy's starting at 9:11 am and at the History Museum (10K) at approximately 3:00 pm. Tegler Hall(5K) at approximately 4:00 pm. You will receive your t-shirt and American flag at the start locations. Books will be stamped at 10K and 5K starts.

TRAIL The trail will be on sidewalks and streets through the city of St. Louis with a police escort. **It is a group walk**. The walk goes to the base of the St. Louis Arch. After a short ceremony at the Arch buses will return walkers to their start points.

REFRESHMENTS: Water and restrooms available at the start and all walking stops throughout the walk. Walkers are encouraged to carry water, bandaids, and snacks.



34K: Directions to Mike Duffy's: Take Hwy 64 west to 61 N. At exit 22, take ramp right for N Outer Forty Rd towards Woods Mill Rd Take ramp left and follow signs for MO-141 South. Take ramp right for Woods Mill toward Clayton Rd .Bear right onto S. Woods Mill Rd. Turn left on MO-HH/Clayton Rd. Turn right on Woodsmill Plaza. Arrive at 102 Schnucks Woodsmill Plaza.

10K: Directions to the History Museum: Take Hwy 64 to North Kingshighway Blvd. Continue on N Kingshighway Blvd to Forest Park Pkwy. Turn left. Follow Forest Park Pkwy to Lindell Blvd. Turn left, the History Museum is at 5700 Lindell Blvd.

5K walkers start at Tegler Hall (Lindell just east of Grand). There is metered street parking and a parking garage at Olive and Compton, just 1 block east of Tegler Hall. (Lindell becomes Olive)

Metrolink is also convenient to 10k. 5k starts and return from the Arch.
