The next Illinois Trekkers Traditional walking event is scheduled for Saturday, August 19, 2017 in Germantown, IL. Read the below article that appeared in the August/September 2017 *The American Wanderer* (TAW):

Germantown's 50th Anniversary Spassfest Volksmarch

A Spassfest is a fun festival and Germantown, Illinois is celebrating their 50th Anniversary Spassfest, Germantown's celebration of its German heritage. The fun begins on August 18 at 4 pm and runs through Sunday August 20 at noon, Every German celebration has good food that includes bratwurst and knackwurst, Germantown's famous fried chicken, homemade German potato salad, fish, hamburgers, and funnel cakes. The Spassfest is a weekend of music, food, celebration, fun, and "Gemütlichkeit". The Spassfest is held in "Red" Schoendienst Park, along Illinois Route 161. Germantown is in Clinton County, Illinois, only 45 minutes from St. Louis, and 15 minutes from Carlyle Lake. The Spassfest grounds are handicapped accessible and as always admission and parking are free. On Friday evening the "Bierlauf" (beer run) will be held at 7 pm. A "Bierlauf" is a one mile run where a person drinks a beer and then runs a quarter of a mile, drinks another beer and runs a quarter of mile, and so on until a mile is completed. The Illinois Trekkers invite walkers to help Germantown, Illinois celebrate their 50th Anniversary Spassfest on August 19 with a Volksmarch (walk) starting at the Red Schoendienst Park. Red Schoendienst Park is named in honor of Red Schoendienst who was born in Germantown and became a ST. Louis Cardinal player, coach and manager. Red Schoendienst was named to the Cooperstown MLB Hall of Fame. Walkers may start between 8 am and 11 am. There are two 5k loops with a guided walk starting at 8:30 am with a member of the Germantown Historic Society walking with walkers to share the history of Germantown with

walkers, When the walkers return from the first loop, another guided walk will start at approximately 9:30 to 9:45 with a member of the Germantown Historic Society walking with walkers again to share the history of Germantown. The first 5k loop is on sidewalks and cities streets and will pass a replica of Red Schoendienst's Cooperstown MLB Hall of Fame Plaque. The walk continues through St. Boniface Cemetery with the Stations of the Cross that were erected in 1893 and have inscriptions in German. The walk will continue through Veterans Memorial Park and historic Germantown. The second 5k loop is on city sidewalks and streets through historic Germantown. Walkers must finish by 2 pm.

After completing the walk, walkers can take a trip to a private fort that will be open to walkers. A shuttle bus will be available from 10 am to 2 pm for walkers to tour the private fort. The shuttle bus to the fort is provided by the Germantown Historic Society for a donation. The fort contains old log cabins that have been moved to the fort from their original locations, antiques and an arrow head collection. A member of the Historical Society will be at the fort to provide historical information about the cabins and Germantown.
