#### **ONLINE START BOXES [OSB]**

Have you tried the OSB yet? Many of the local walks now have OSB capabilities. Check them out!!!

Leonard Wojtysiak has been terribly busy tackling the task of creating OSB for Trekker events that have complicated start locations. Both the Maryville YMCA (walk & bike) and the Edwardsville YMCA (walk & swim) have restrictions on access to the facility. The start binders for all four events have been in possession of the POC Vickie Ridgeway. She and Leonard worked together to develop OSB for these events. Again, to sign up through the OSB, you must create a personal account at my.ava.org. You will be asked to establish a credit card on this account and add money in it to be eligible to sign up for walks. This is applicable for all OSB events throughout the United States. Numerous clubs have created OSB for their events due to the restrictions placed on start locations by the **COVID** pandemic. Please note that the Gateway Milers have their events with OSB options as does the Saint Louis Walkers (formerly the St Louis-Stuttgart Club). Thank you, Leonard.

#### DIANE GEBHARDT'S VOLKSMARCH STORY

Having spent years as a pre-school mom, a band parent, a football mom, etc., I was looking for a hobby or such which would be MINE. I was not interested in competition—just being active, seeing things, being with friends. A fellow teacher told me about these walks which were set up in scenic and/or historic places. This idea sounded interesting.

Thus, in April of 1990 my next-door neighbor, Linda Badger, and I took our instruction sheet in hand and went on our first volksmarch. That was a good decision; while we were both teaching, we continued to explore the sites around our area on weekends and during the summer. On these volksmarches, I met Norma and Jim Jones who were in charge of the Traveling Trekkers. Thanks to them and their expertise, I took several bus trips in Illinois.

When I retired from teaching, those trips were longer. In 2002 Carol Gendron and I walked up the Crazy Horse monument. That same year Helen Radosevich and I went to Michigan, walked across the Mackinac Bridge (with thousands of other people) and stayed on Mackinaw Island. That was my first and only 13K volksmarch! Helen and I also did an East Coast trip visiting many lighthouses and eating fresh lobster and fresh blueberries.

For several years I collected the "awards" from volksmarches—patches, suncatchers, Christmas ornaments, coffee mugs, etc. After I had MANY patches, I decided I wanted to display them. It was hard to choose from among hundreds of them. Ultimately, I picked patches from special walks or those with unusual shapes. I whip-stitched 48 patches on 9" x 9" white fabric squares, and a friend put them together into a lovely wall hanging.

When my husband retired, we started going to FL for a few months each year. Diane Prost introduced me to Volks South, a group led by Doug and Jackie from New York, which meets once a week in FL to enjoy YREs together. Sometimes my husband and I were joined by Diane and her husband Tim when they were also in FL.

When asked to pick my favorite walks, that was very difficult. I have enjoyed Eckert's Apple Orchard many times; the Shrine of Our Lady of the Snows is always inspirational; Lake Louise in Canada was very beautiful. I have now walked in all 50 states; I have seen so many things which you miss when you cross the USA just traveling on interstate highways.

In closing I want to say thank you to those of you who are serving and have served as officers of clubs, as POCs, as regional and national directors to make volksmarches possible for all of us. Your time and effort are sincerely appreciated. Long love volksmarching; let's continue to walk, talk, and eat!

<u>S. Alamo Street, San Antonio, TX 78210</u>. Be sure to use this address in the future if sending IVV Record Books or other correspondence.


#### **AVA Headquarters**
