2022 STARTING POINT PREVIEW AND EVENT ANALYSIS REPORT

Just Click on "Go" - Clubs may now preview how their Year Round and Seasonal Events (YRE/SEs) will appear in the upcoming 2022 Starting Point. Clubs are strongly encouraged to review all of their 2022 YRE/SEs using this report created by clicking the "GO" button below the heading, "2022 Club Starting Point Report". Shown below is an image of this button from a club my.ava.org home page.



Create Report PDF including an analysis with recommendations for improvement.

The report PDF contains two sections.

Starting Point Listing - The first section of the report includes an introductory page followed by the club's 2022 YRE/SE information formatted as it will appear in the 2022 Starting Point Book.

Event Analysis - The second section contains an introductory page followed by an analysis of each YRE/SE with recommendations for improvement.

Sell it and Location - Please use this pdf report to confirm your 2022 event data is accurate and includes the use of the my.ava.org specific event features accessible via the "Sell It" and "Location" tabs.

Unapproved and Approved Events - Until 9/15/2021, the events listed in the report can be unapproved and approved events. After this date, the report will only contain RD approved events.

Update and Repeat - Changes to the my.ava.org event data will appear immediately in the next report. However, any changes to the legacy ESR event data can take up to 30 hours to appear on my.ava.org and therefore in the next report. OSB and OSB/PSB - While OSB (Online Start Box) and OSB/PSB (Online Start Box / Physical Start Box) events renewed from 2021 will inherit their OSB or OSB/PSB designation and event pdf, clubs may choose to designate a PSB event as an OSB or OSB/PSB event starting in 2022. When a 2022 YRE/SE is marked as OSB or OSB/PSB (via the OSB tab), it will appear in the Starting Point as an OSB or OSB/PSB event independent whether the club has uploaded the required event pdf and obtained OSB customer service approval. The assumption here is that the club will upload the required event pdf file and submit the event for OSB approval well before (at least four weeks prior to) the event's start date.

Deadline 10/11/2021 - It is expected the Starting Point book event data will be shipped to publisher on or about 10/18/2021. Clubs need to have all their changes in place before the 10/11/2021 deadline.

2023 IVV OLYMPIAD UPDATES.

Planning continues for hosting the 2023 IVV Olympiad in San Antonio, Texas. AVA: America's Walking Club! will be hosting the first Olympiad ever to be held in North America!

Save The Dates! Our joint event – the IVV Olympiad and the existing IML Texas Trail Round Up, will take place back-to back from 19-23 FEB and 24-26 FEB 2023. That's a whole week of fantastic walks (from 5k - 42k), bikes and swims, in a once-in-a-



lifetime international atmosphere. America's Walking Club is bringing together the two largest international walking federations to bring these events to the USA. Who are they you ask?



The INTERNATIONALER VOLKSSPORTVERBAND – or International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) – is the governing organization for volkssports, internationally, comprised of 3 geographic regions (Europe, Asia & Americas), 31 national members and 10 countries with single (club) members. America's Walking Club and all our member clubs are part of the IVV.

The IML Walking Association (known until 2006 as the International Marching League) is a non-profit organization which promotes recreational walking in the form of international non-competitive multi-day walking events or "marches" in its member countries. There are 29 member nations holding IML events, including the United States – with events hosted in Arlington, VA and San Antonio, TX.
