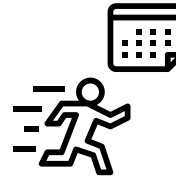

A NEW SANCTION PRINT CAPABILITY ON MY.AVA.ORG.

'my.ava.org' is intended to fully replace the legacy ESR system and this is an ongoing project. In the meantime there are smaller but important additions to the new web site that are occurring. Being able to easily print the sanction is one such addition.

The sanction "view" had a legacy system 'link' that allowed people to view and print the sanction from there. Some had trouble printing the web page view. Now there is a "D'load long format PDF" button that does what you expect. It provides you with a PDF of the sanction that you can print or simply keep on your phone or tablet while you travel.

The long format provides you everything in the sanction request including the pictures. (There is much additional information in the PSB and/or the OSB event directions). At this time it is not possible to customize the PDF. Customization would be quite a bit of additional work and would add a layer of complexity and possible confusion to people who just want to click and print (most of us). I would be interested in suggestions that would improve the printout and will quickly incorporate the easy ones. The more complex ideas will have to go on what is still a pretty long list of web site improvements.

The second button, "D'load info PDF", is an idea that I have bounced around for a few years. Only now have I had a compelling need to create this. It is essentially a "brochure" for the event driven solely from information in the sanction. It will provide a generic, but good looking, brochure substitute for all events including YRE's and Seasonals. It is designed to be a brochure format, printed double sided, but the first page has everything needed to get to the event if there is a Physical Start Box (PSB). If the event is hosted on the Online Start Box (OSB), then the directions are found in the downloaded event directions.

Again, this PDF cannot be customized so it will not satisfy every club or individual. There may be issues with the format or language that is not what your club wants. This is solved by one of two methods. The first is to create and upload your own brochure. Your brochure will replace the generic one for the specific event. The second option is to disable the generic brochure for your club's events. Simply send an email to "chris@zegelin.com" that includes your club code (AVA-xxxx).

If your event currently has a brochure that has been uploaded to my.ava.org (via the "Sell it" feature), then you will not see the "D'load info PDF" button.

*** TO DO ***

The "Info PDF" uses the AVA logo as a default. If you upload your clubs logo, that will be used instead. This is another new feature. In your club's account, click the "Profile" tab and then the "Logo" tab. The instructions are there.

*** IMPORTANT ***

Many years ago, the Starting Point was changed to provide an "Event Information" field. This field was filled from the "extra description" field found in the legacy ESR instead of the "comments" field. Somehow this caused a mess in our database that is easy to fix... now. Basically about half the sanctions have these fields reversed. When a sanction is being printed the difference is obvious when all the sanction fields are presented in a logical order. Look at the printout for your sanctions and if they do not feel right, you can swap the two fields with a click. Go to your club account, tab to 'Sanctions' then 'Sell it'. Click the 'Swap fields' button... done. You can check all of your sanctions while you are on the "Sell it" page.

"Event Information" should contain all of the must-read information about restrooms, parking, pets, and such. "Comments" allows you to provide additional detail about what you will see on the trail. Web search engines are very good at finding interesting things to read about a selected subject but they need original content and some help. The future of the "comments" field and the event pictures will be to provide the right sort of content. Marketing is vitally important to AVA's and Volkssporting's future. Our database needs a thorough cleanup before we can make use of this free resource to entice people to participate with us.

The new ESR code is in progress. It is complex because there are lots of details that have to be incorporated. So far, I am very pleased with how it is coming together with several new features that will help everyone. The target date for going live is February of 2022. The plan is to have a major article with details in the next Wanderer, and then again in the January Checkpoint.
