ONLINE START BOXES [OSB]

Have you tried the OSB yet? Many of the local walks now have OSB capabilities. Check them out!!!

Leonard Wojtysiak has been terribly busy tackling the task of creating OSB for Trekker events that have complicated start locations. Both the Maryville YMCA (walk & bike) and the Edwardsville YMCA (walk & swim) have restrictions on access to the facility. The start binders for all four events have been in possession of the POC Vickie Ridgeway. She and Leonard worked together to develop OSB for these events. Again, to sign up through the OSB, vou must create a personal account at my.ava.org. You will be asked to establish a credit card on this account and add money in it to be eligible to sign up for walks. This is applicable for all OSB events throughout the United States. Numerous clubs have created OSB for their events due to the restrictions placed on start locations by the COVID pandemic. Please note that the Gateway Milers have their events with OSB options as does the Saint Louis Walkers (formerly the St Louis-Stuttgart Club). Thank you, Leonard.
