A NEW RAW SANCTION TEXT CAPABILITY ON MY.AVA.ORG.

As I add features to 'my.ava.org', some of the legacy system features will disappear. Unfortunately I have no way to know if those features were in fact used, or were simply artifacts that can be ignored. I need to hear from you about these features. How do you use them and for what purpose. I can't promise to restore all requests, and I certainly can't spend endless hours trying to make something work that is incompatible with the new system.

One such feature was the ability to 'select and paste' the sanction into an email or a document. The new PDF files and web pages make 'select and paste' more complex and beyond the comfort level of many users. This feature has been restored, but in a way that works on the new design. Security concerns require that this raw sanction text be available only to those who have access to the club account.

Login to 'my.ava.org', then click to go to your club account. Click on 'Sanctions', then 'Sanctions' again. This will give you a list of all approved sanctions for your club. The new 'select and paste' feature is the 'Text' button. Click it and the sanction text will be copied into your systems clipboard. You can then paste it where you need it, and edit as necessary.
