CALL TO 2023 SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

I hereby notify all AVA National Officers, Regional Directors, State Organizations, and AVA Member Clubs of the February 24, 2023, American Volkssport Association Special Membership Meeting and invite you to participate.

The AVA will hold a Special Membership Meeting at the La Quinta Inn and Suites by Wyndham San Antonio Riverwalk, 303 Blum, San Antonio, Texas, on Friday, February 24, 2023, from 1:30pm to 4:30pm.
