CHANGES TO TRAVELING GUIDED WALKS

Effective July 1, 2022, clubs are not required to sanction a Traditional event within the calendar year to be eligible to sanction Traveling Guided Walks (TGW). The cost for the Traveling Guided Walk sanction and stamp will be \$105.00.Extra stamps are \$5.00 and extra handles are \$9.00.

The event includes seven days of walk, bike and swim events. The IVV Olympiad is February 19-22, 2023, followed by the IML Texas Trail Roundup February 24-26.Register now at: ivvolympiad2023.org and get an early-bird discount on the registration. Choose all seven days, or fewer days, depending on your schedule.

Walks vary daily from 42K, 21K, 10K or 5K. There are also three bike events and two swim events planned. Plus registrants will get an Olympiad Pass that includes access to the Olympiad Village at La Villita - a national historic arts village with more than 25 shops, restaurants and galleries.

BASE SANCTIONING FEE FOR ONE QUARTER SEASONAL WALKING EVENTS

The ability to create/edit/approve events on my.ava.org, hereafter referred to as the new ESR allows clubs to choose to easily create all types of events: traditional, year round, and seasonal events at any time of the year. As per the AVA Policy Manual, the sanctioning fee for a traditional walking event is \$30. However, for a seasonal walking event with a start and end date falling within a single quarter, the total sanction fee is \$25 (\$20 base fee + \$5 quarterly fee). So prior to the fee change detailed below, a club was able to choose to create a seasonal event with a duration as small as 1 day instead of a traditional event to avoid paying \$5 more in sanctioning fees.

Indeed, creating seasonal walking events instead of traditional walking events may likely become more popular since some clubs have and are considering sanctioning short duration seasonal walking events so as to have Online Start Box (OSB) support for their events. (See the following article on using OSB for short term seasonal events.)

In any case, it is unfair to those who sanction traditional walking events instead of seasonal walking events. Also, any increase of the sanctioning of seasonal walking events in place of traditional walking events, under the previous sanctioning fee rules, would have a negative impact on AVA revenues.

Therefore, effective immediately, the base sanctioning fee for an event in the class of seasonal walking events, where start and end dates fall in the same quarter is changed from \$20 to \$25. This change makes the total sanctioning fee for an event in this class equal to \$30 (\$25 base fee plus \$5 quarterly fee) which is the same as for a traditional walking event. The fees for any other seasonal that is not in this class remain the same. So, for example, the base sanctioning fee for seasonal non-walking events and seasonal walking events where the start and ends fall in different quarters remains \$20.

USING THE ONLINE START BOX FOR SHORT TERM SEASONAL EVENTS

Only seasonal and year round events are supported by the OSB (not traditional events). Recently, a couple of AVA clubs have sanctioned or are considering sanctioning short term (1 to a few days) seasonal events instead of a traditional event, so as to have Online Start Box (OSB) for their events.

Using the OSB for short term seasonal has certain advantages including providing a way for the event participants to register for events, downloading directions (at no expense to the club), completing/paying for events online, and having the event participation data automatically imported into the next quarterly participation report/invoice. Once event participants "finish" their event online, clubs are able to download participation sign-in sheet reports for their records.

On possible disadvantage of using the OSB is that until event participants have "finished" their events online, the club has no visibility as to who has registered or how many have registered for their event. In fact, OSB registrants are permitted to completely delete their registration instead of finishing their events.

The impact of not knowing the number of folks who have registered for an event could complicate club planning for the event. For example, how much parking is required to accommodate event participants. One way to mitigate this problem would be to request/require registrants to go ahead and finish their event online. This would require participants to enter the expected walking distance prior to actually doing the walk. (This distance would appear on any generated online distance insert cards, but walkers are permitted to later manually modify their distance insert cards to reflect the distance they walked.)

Also, a registered/finished OSB participant may or may not have downloaded directions for an event that they expect to have a staffed starting point with directions to distribute. So, the sponsoring club should make it clear in the online event information that OSB participants are expected to have downloaded their directions for use at the event. Then of course, be prepared to handle a few folks that downloaded their events but managed to not bring them to the event.



EDITING DEFAULT PDF EVENT BROCHURE ON MY.AVA

October 2021 it was announced that there would be some changes added to your events page on my.AVA.org. One of the changes introduced was a default downloadable pdf brochure for events that were entered without uploading a brochure. The pdf template compiles event information entered into a foldable print out that can be used a flyer. This default pdf brochure contains a FEE section that references free walkers. Clubs are free to remove or edit this statement as necessary by doing the following:

- 1. Design your own pdf event brochure and upload it on the "Sell It" tab. AVA provides downloadable Word event brochure templates for everyone to use to make a pdf event brochure. Click here to find templates.
- 2. Download the default pdf event brochure that is provided on My.AVA, save it to your computer, open with word and edit the text. Once you have edited the text you can resave as a pdf and then upload through the "Sell It" tab
- 3. Email Chris Zegelin, OSB Developer at chris@zegelin.com. Include your Club number and a request to disable the downloadable pdf event brochure.

CALL FOR PROPOSALS TO HOST THE 2025 AVA BIENNIAL CONVENTION

The American Volkssport Association (AVA), America's Walking Club is issuing a Request For Proposals (RFP) for local clubs jointly applying, a singular club and/or state association to host the 2025 AVA Biennial Convention. RFP documents are available upon request from the National Office.

Typically every two years the membership of the AVA convenes for seven (7) to nine (9) days to participate in some of the best organized walks in America as well as other noncompetitive fitness activities before, during and after a national general membership business meeting. We refer to this convening as our biennial convention. The number of individuals who attend the full convention could be approximately 350. However, the number of individuals who attend the walks and social events exceeds 700! Our goal is to increase these numbers by 25%.

The biennial convention includes the business meeting (two one-half day sessions), workshops, socials, an AVA Board Meeting, silent auction, cash raffle, exhibit booths and health fair, walking events and other noncompetitive physical fitness activities which take place during three days of the convention and the a nine-day convening period with pre and post convention activities.

November 9 National Office and the Convention Committee Present Semi-Finalists to the Board at the Board Meeting Requesting Board Input, and if Desired, a Board Recommendation

February 20-23 or 20-26 Semi-Finalists Will Be Offered a Booth in San Antonio to Share Information

February 24, 2023 Membership Business Meeting - In-Person or Video Presentations by Semi-Finalists

March 2023Member Delegates Selection/Vote - Virtual Voting (Date to be selected.)

April 3, 2023 Finalist Selected Will Be Notified, as Well as the Runner-up

April 2023 - May 2025 Local Preparation and Scheduling for 2025 Convention Activities Continuous Contact With National Office Staff and the Convention Committee (National Office Executive Director Approves and Signs All Convention Related Contracts)


